The Family Centre wants to ensure that the challenges can be sorted early. You are welcome to come with both large and small questions, before they become too difficult to handle and before your daily life gets too complicated.

Practitioners from the Division of children, family and health, Child Welfare Service and NAV are available for a conversation/consulting.

Topics that can be addressed:

- Interactions between children/adolescents and adults – family relations
- Boundaries in the upbringing - parenting
- Children's mental and physical health
- Youth life's challenges
- Conflict management within the family
- Interaction in relationships
- Social/economic issues
